Monroe County Heritage Days

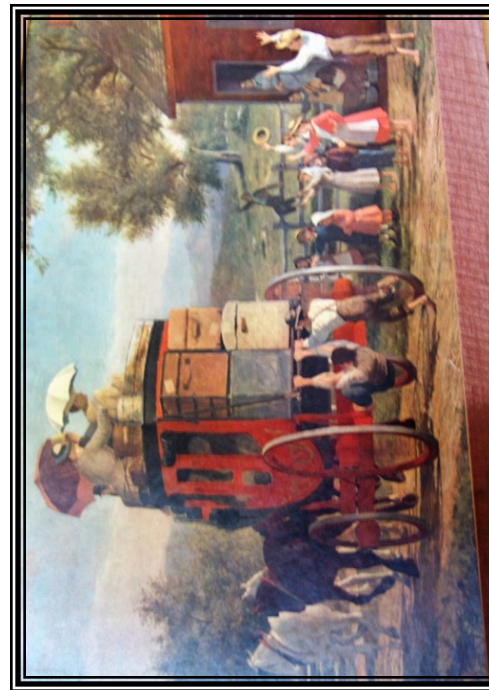

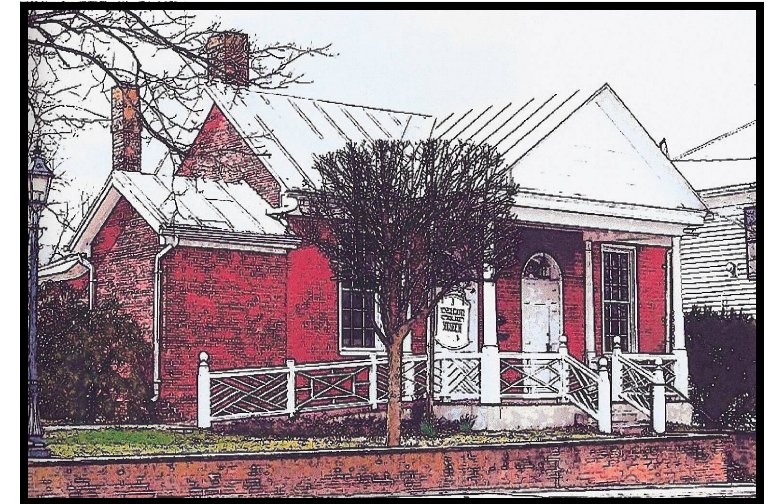
